

# Narrow Gauge Cog Road Runs to Zoo

Tiny Cadillac-powered streamliner known as "the Mountaineer," which runs from Penrose Stadium to Cheyenne Mountain Zoo, enjoys the distinction of being the only narrow gauge cog train in the world. It is a miniature edition of the famous Pikes Peak Cog Railway, and carries 20 passengers in each car, making 40 in all. The two little cars are plexiglass topped, allowing the travelers an unobstructed view of the surrounding countryside.

The narrow gauge cog road runs for two miles up to the zoo on the lower slopes of Cheyenne Mountain. The boarding station is located near Spencer Penrose Stadium, the World Arena, the Broadmoor stables, and skirts the Broadmoor golf course before winding its way through the scrub oak and pines which cover the slopes of the mountain. The route has four tunnels, the last one being 150 feet long constructed at the upper terminal to allow the train to stop right outside the Thundergod House, the entrance to the zoo.
