# BARR COMPLETING PIKES PEAK TRAIL TO BOTTOMLESS PIT

Workmen are now engaged in constructing a trail between the new Barr trail to the summit of Pikes Peak and Bottomless pit. It is being built by Fred Barr, builder of the other trail, and will make possible a comparatively easy descent into this great pocket of a canon, which has always been one of the most fascinating features of the Sentinel of

the Rockies. It is the intention to have the trail completed in time for use this summer.

Mr. Barr is himself now in the southern part of the state, securing additional burros for use on the trails which he has leading from the summit of Mt. Manitou. His Pikes Peak trail was completed, except for a short gap high above the timber line, when the snow set in last fall. It will be complete and ready for use this summer. It is a picturesque trail, zigzagging down the face of the mountain overlooking Colorado Springs and passing thru an area of above-timber line ground where boulders as large as houses are piled upon each other like children's blocks. The trail is also a comparatively easy one of ascent.
