

## Man missing; foul play suspected

Foul play is suspected in the disappearance of a 24-year-old Colorado Springs man, missing for more than a week, police said.

Amadeo Vigil left his home between 3 and 4 p.m. on July 11 and has not returned since. Police said his mother said he told her he was going to meet someone at Fort Garland, but that he never reached his destination.

He was last seen hitchhiking near the Bijou Street southbound entrance, police said.

Foul play is suspected because a caller from Texas told the man's mother he had picked up the

hitchhiking Vigil in Texas, and that Vigil said he "feared for his life," police said. The caller said a picture of Vigil matched the appearance of the hitchhiker.

Vigil is described as being 5 feet 6 inches tall, 130 pounds, with brown hair and greenish-brown eyes and a faded scar on his forehead. He was wearing an off-white shirt, levis, a leather necklace with an African bead and a silver chain with a "happy face" on it. He was carrying a green back pack.
